

Notice of Permit Application
Airline Avenue Recycling, LLC
Portland, CT

Notice is hereby given that Airline Avenue Recycling, LLC (the “applicant”) of 555 Taylor Road, Enfield, CT, has submitted to the Department of Energy & Environmental Protection an application under Connecticut General Statutes Section 22a-208a for a permit to conduct a regulated activity in the construction, alteration or operation of solid waste facilities at 285 Airline Avenue Portland, Connecticut.

Specifically, the applicant proposes to renew the current permit with no changes to the total processing and storage capacity. This permit renewal application will allow for the continuation of operations under the existing operating permit No. 11301229-PCO. The Solid Waste permit facility authorizes the permittee to accept 700 tons per day of the following types of waste: (a) construction and demolition debris; (b) oversized MSW; (c) non-putrescible municipal solid waste (MSW) from commercial and industrial sources; (d) scrap tires; (e) Recyclable Items (paper, cardboard, commingled containers, plastics, scrap metal, appliances containing chlorofluorocarbon (CFC) liquid); and (f) Clean Wood (Land Clearing Debris and pallets).
